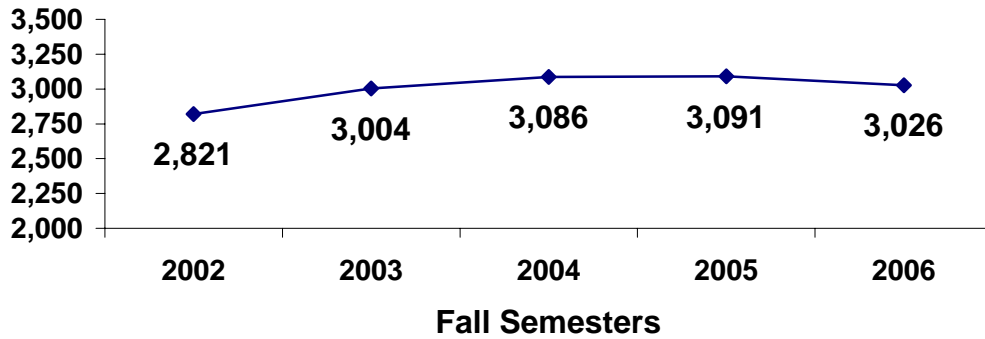

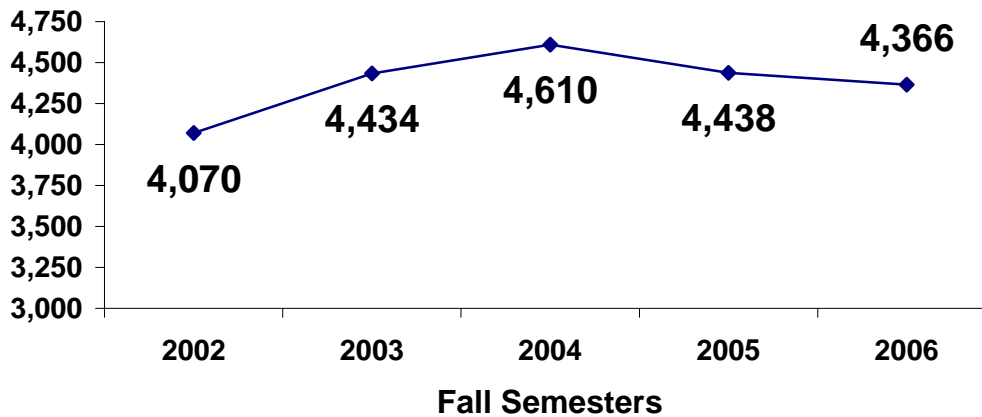
## Main Campus Overall Headcount
