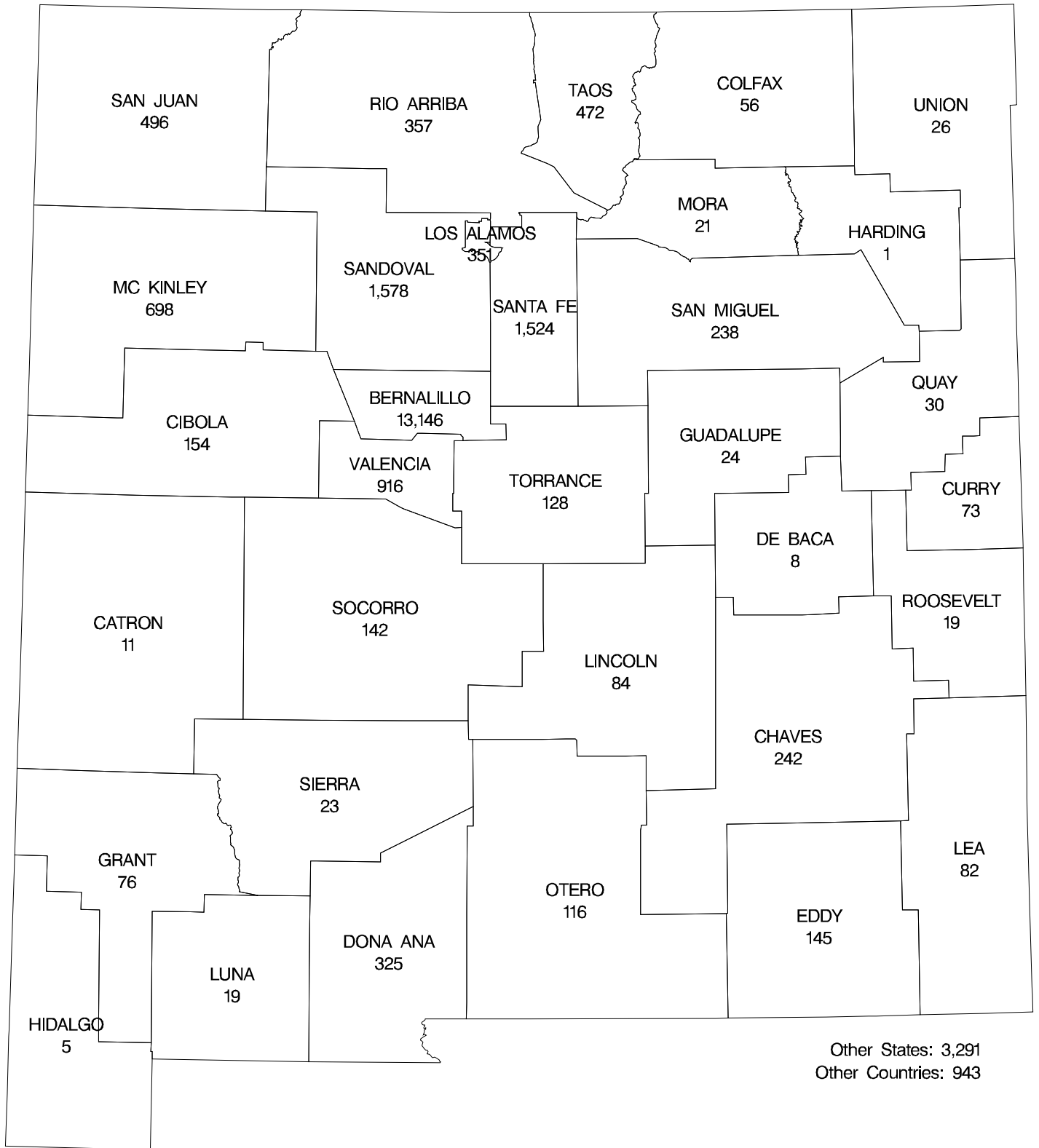

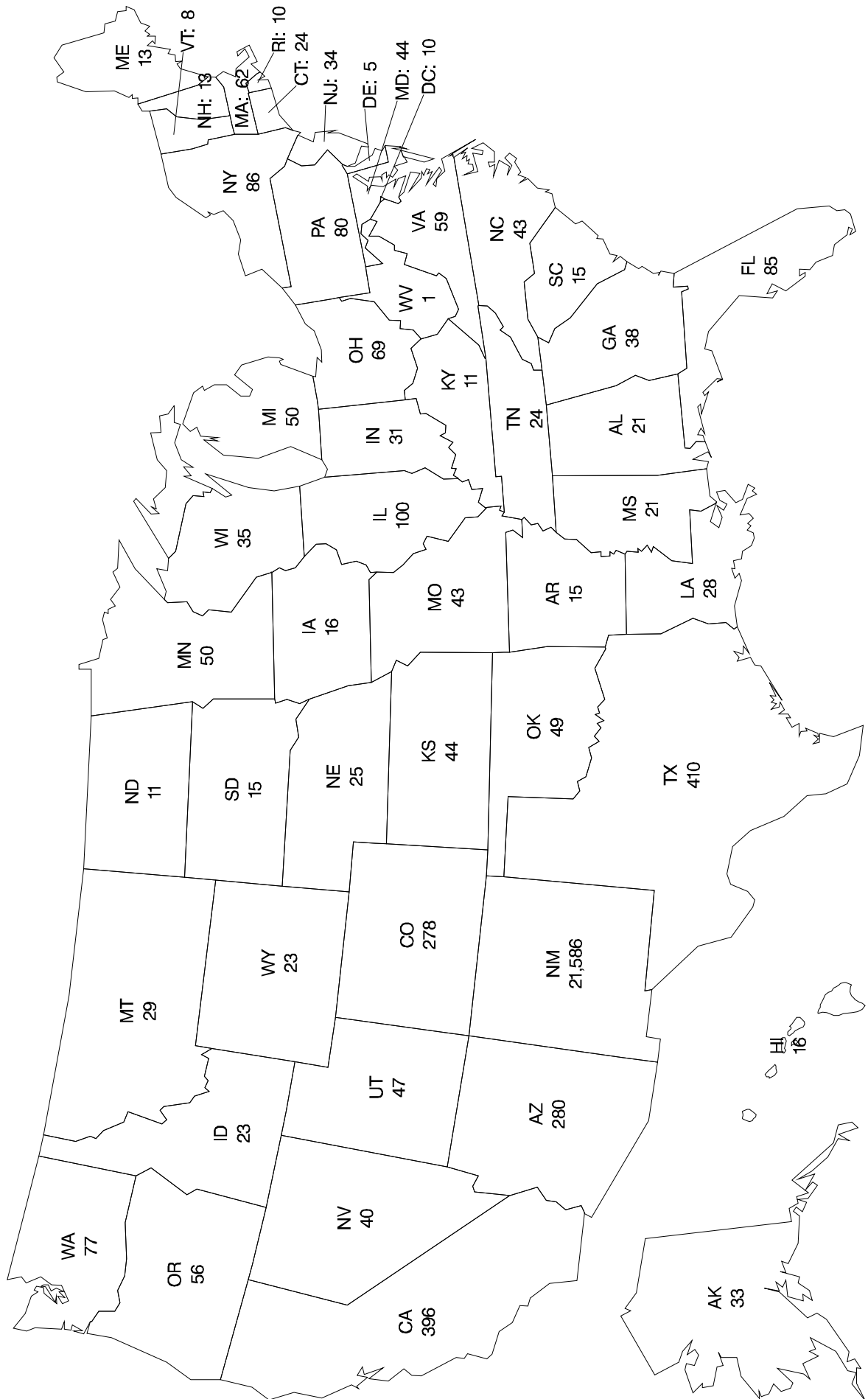
## BY Original Residence\* – ALBUQUERQUE CAMPUS

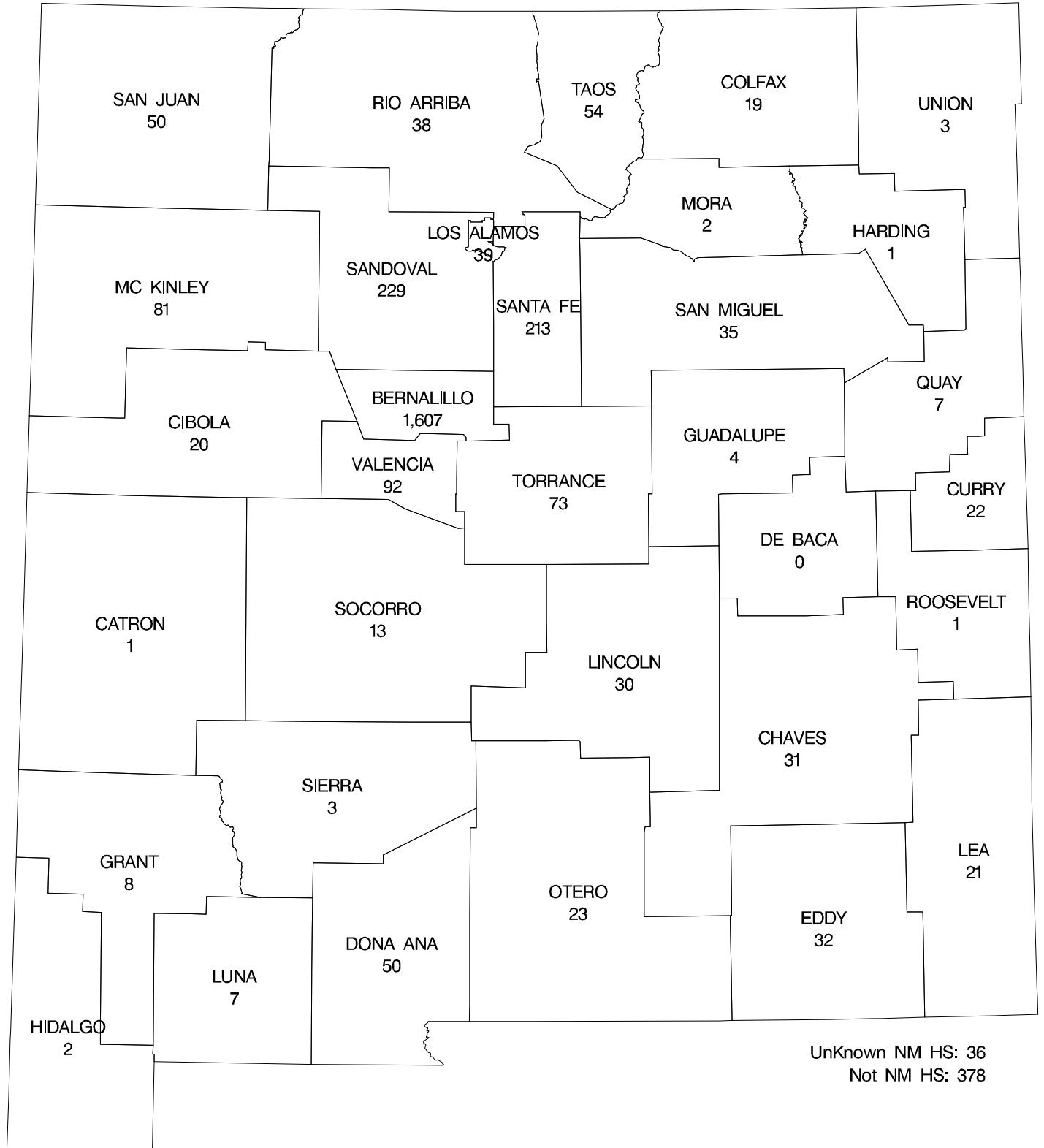
