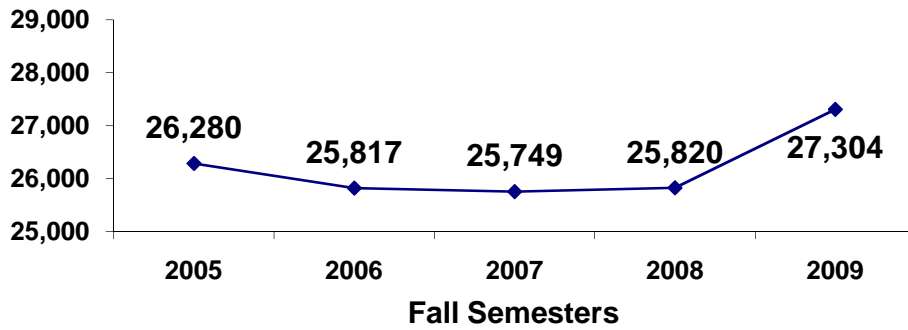

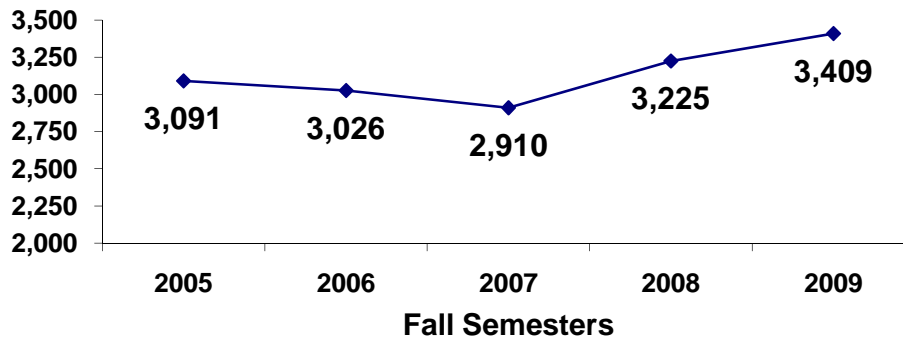

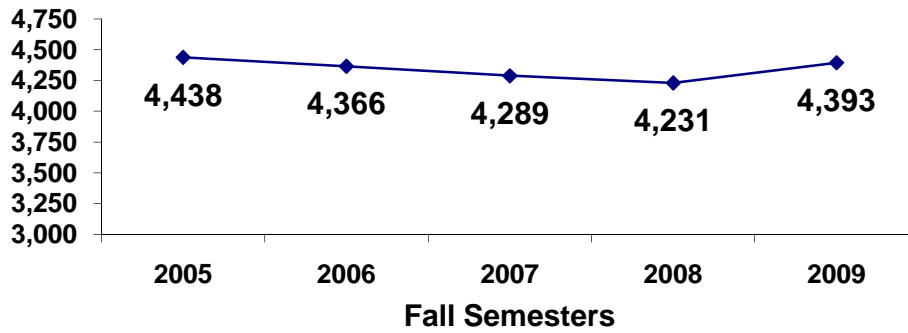
### Albuquerque Campus Overall Headcount

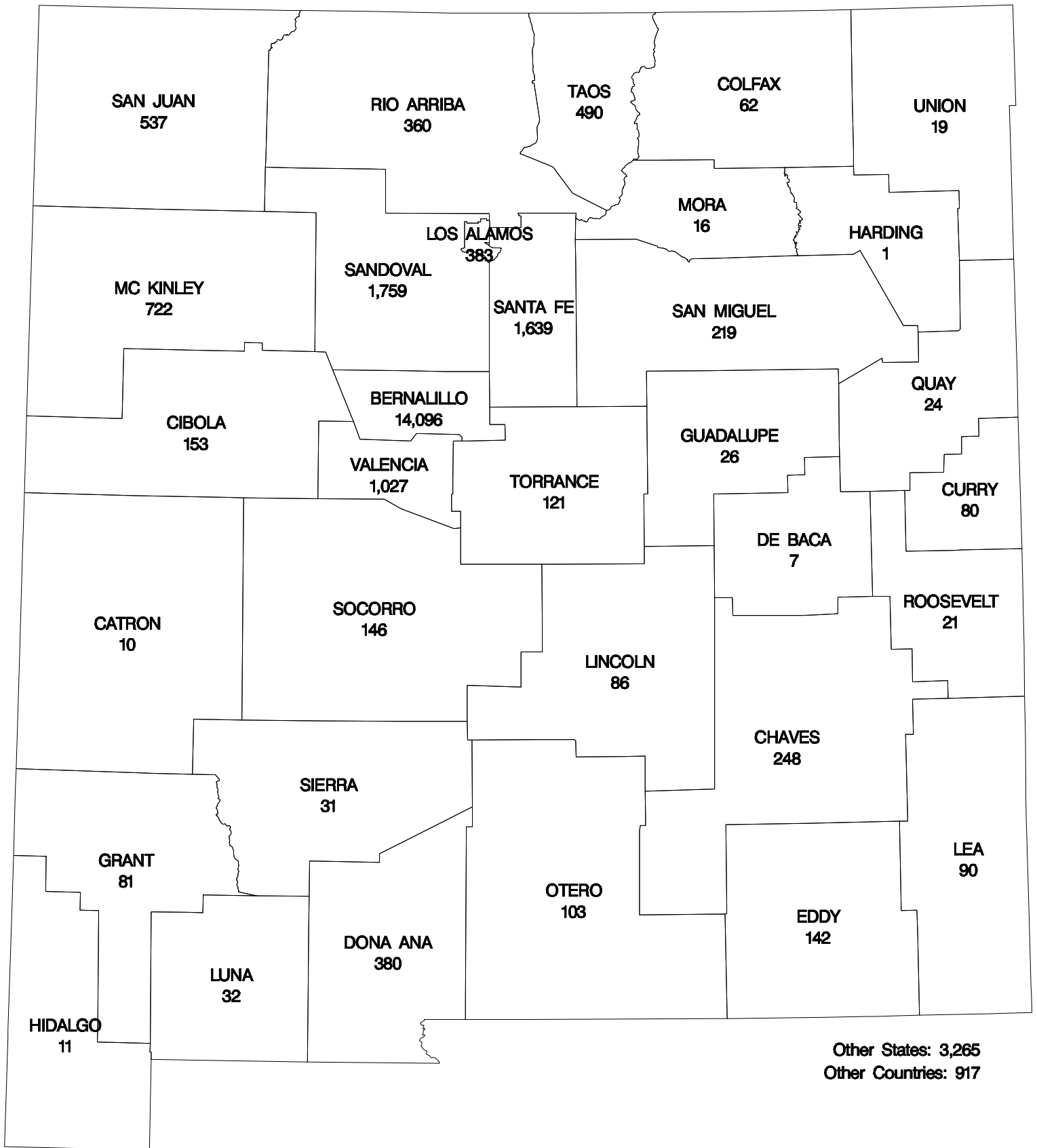

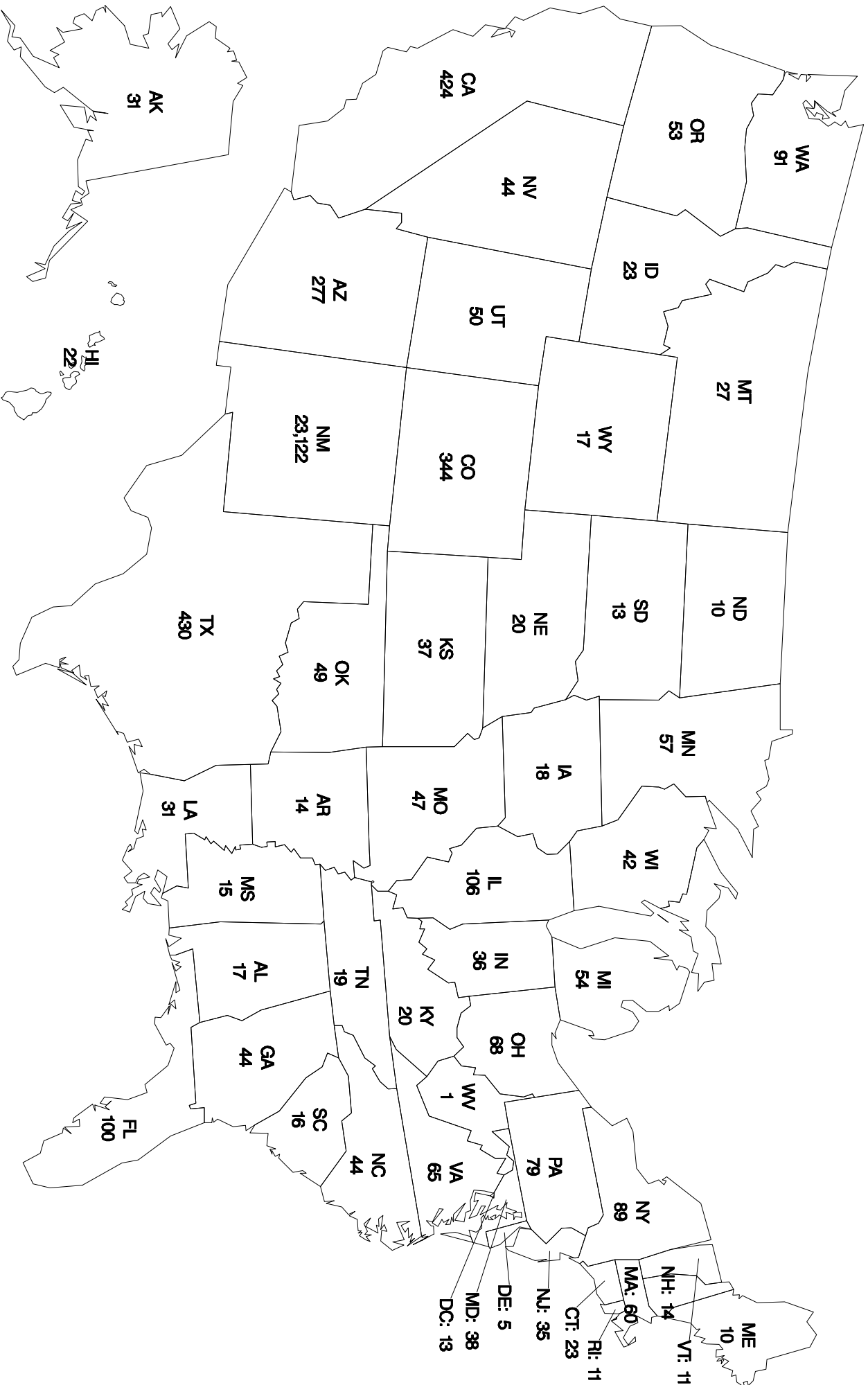

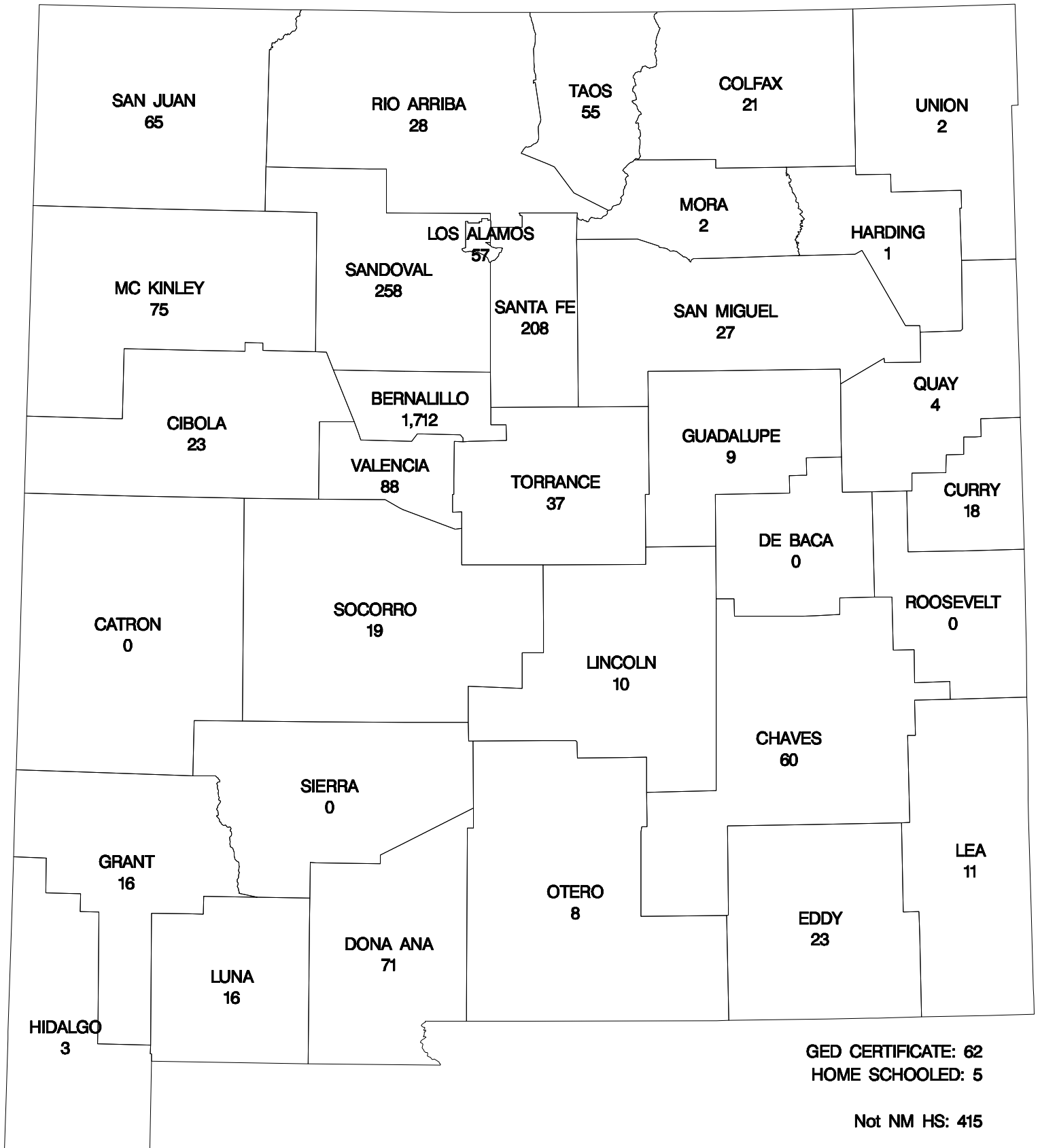
