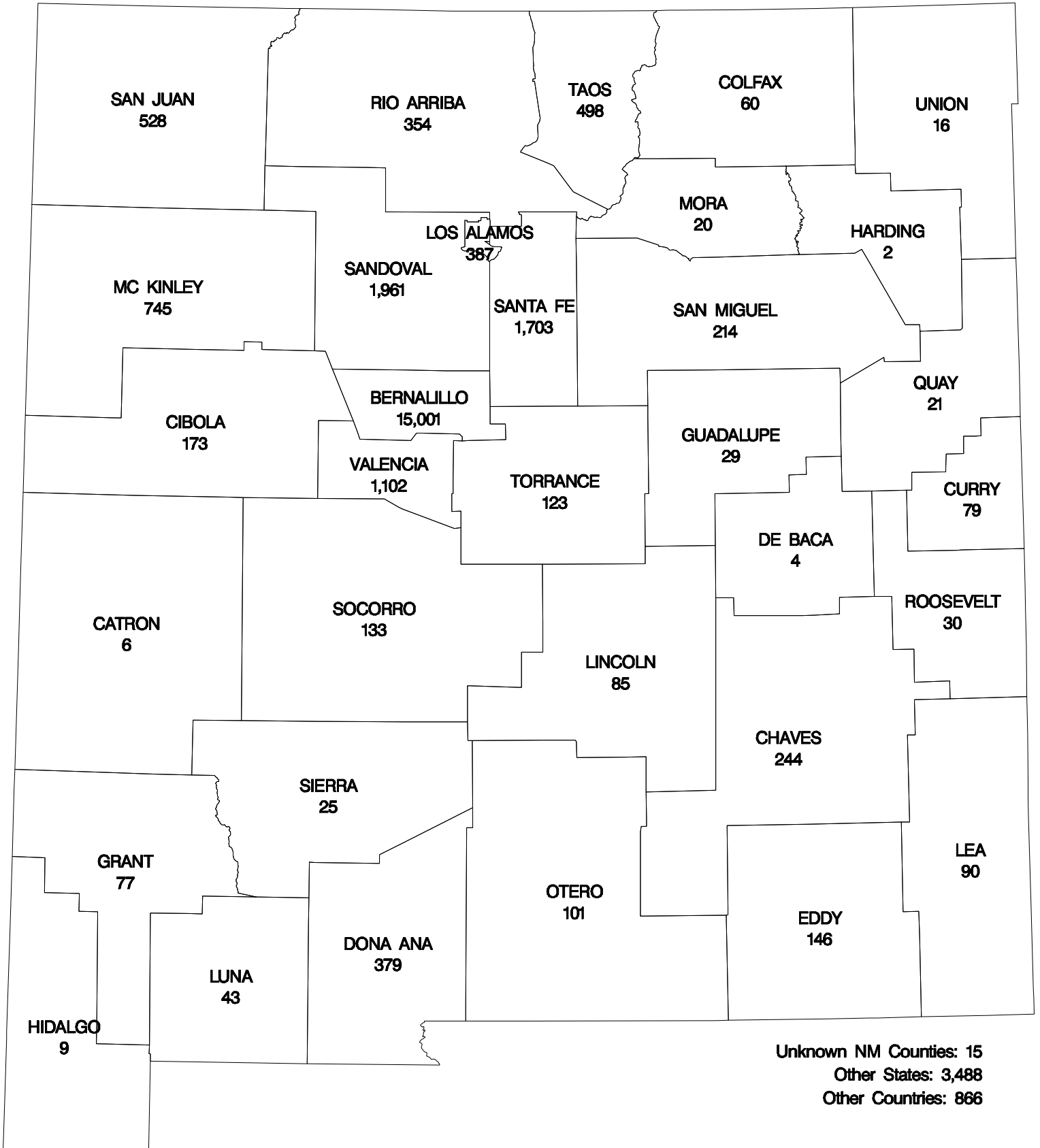

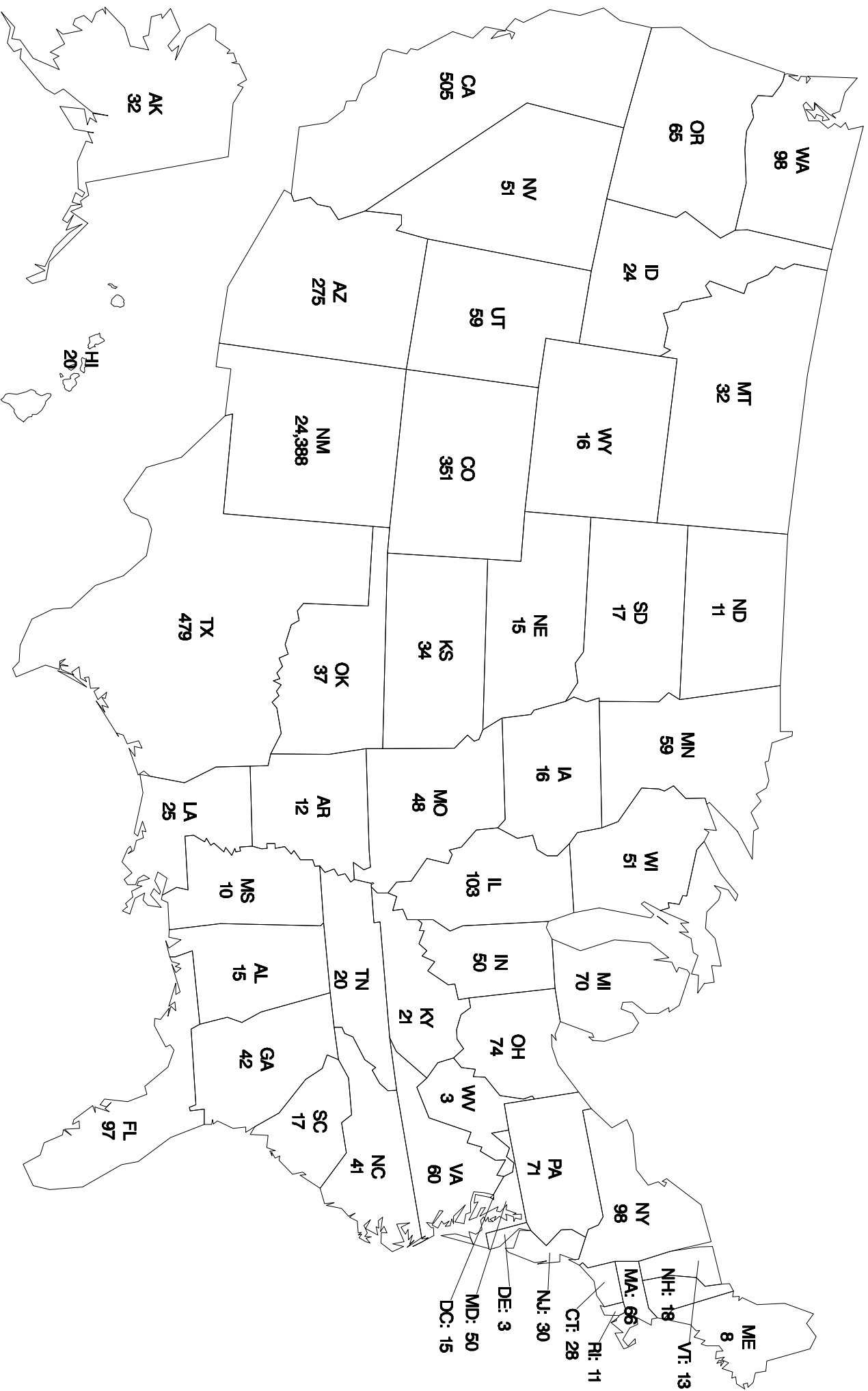
Albuquerque Campus—Based on \*Original Residence

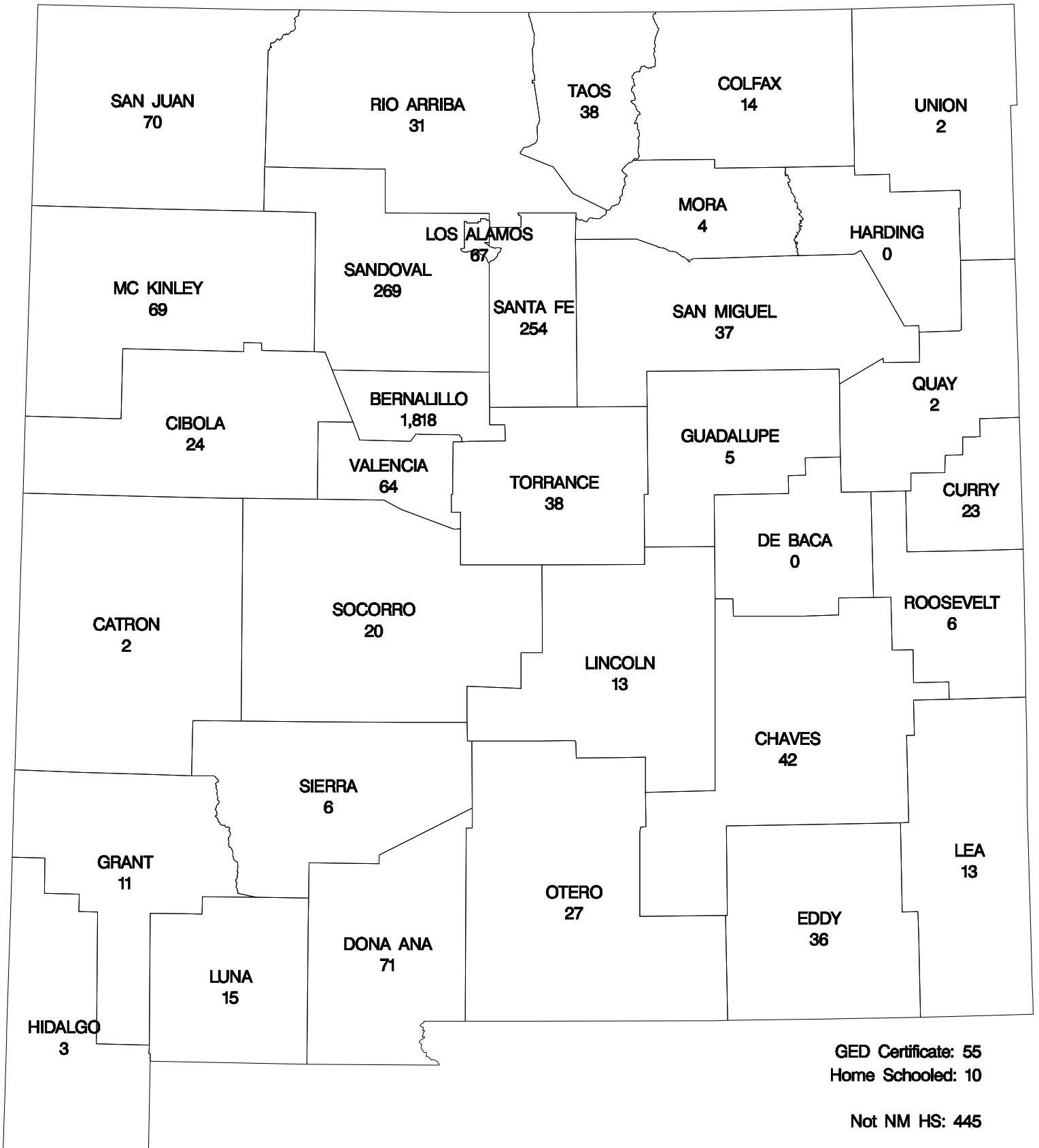
