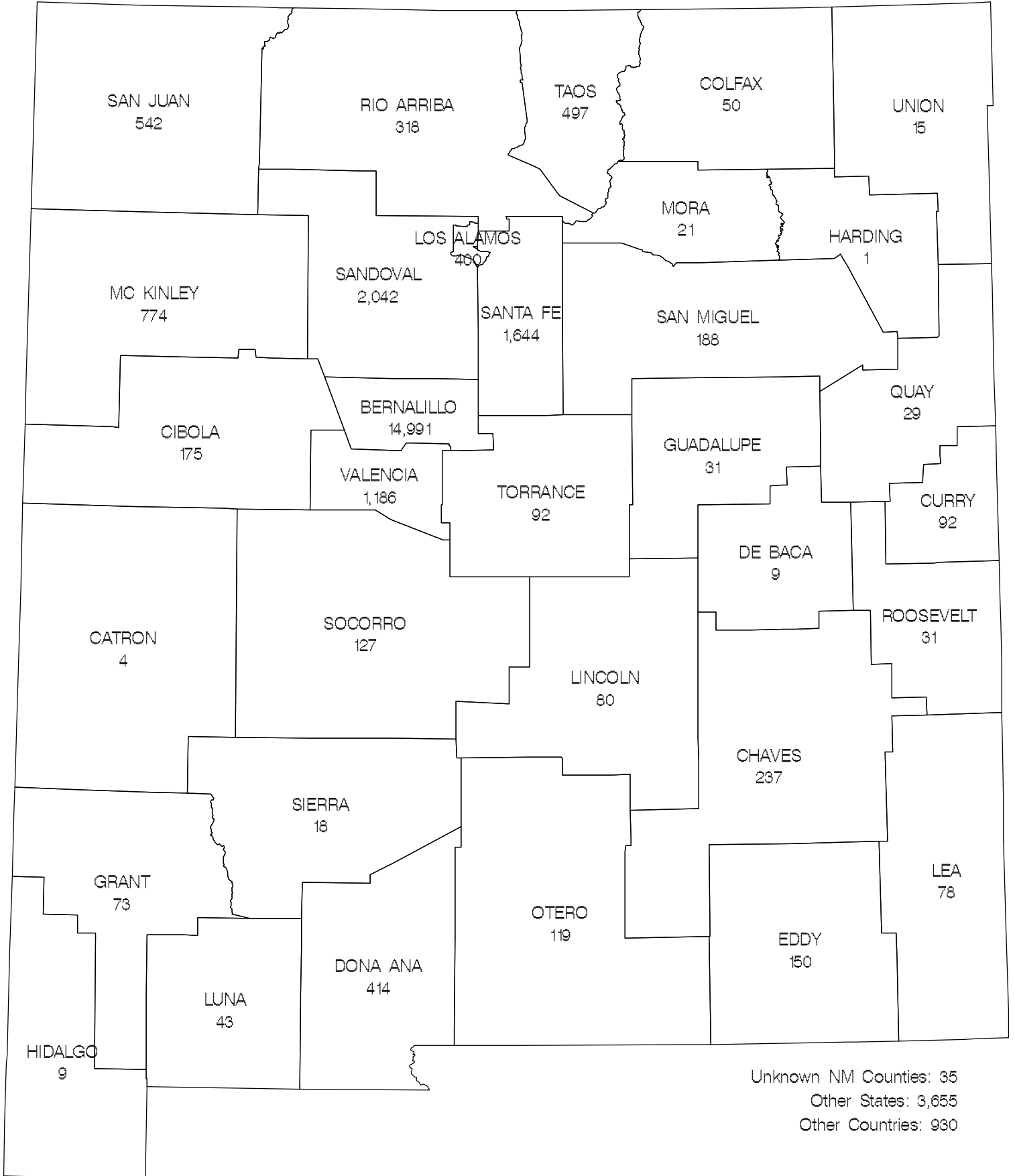

Fall 2012 Headcount

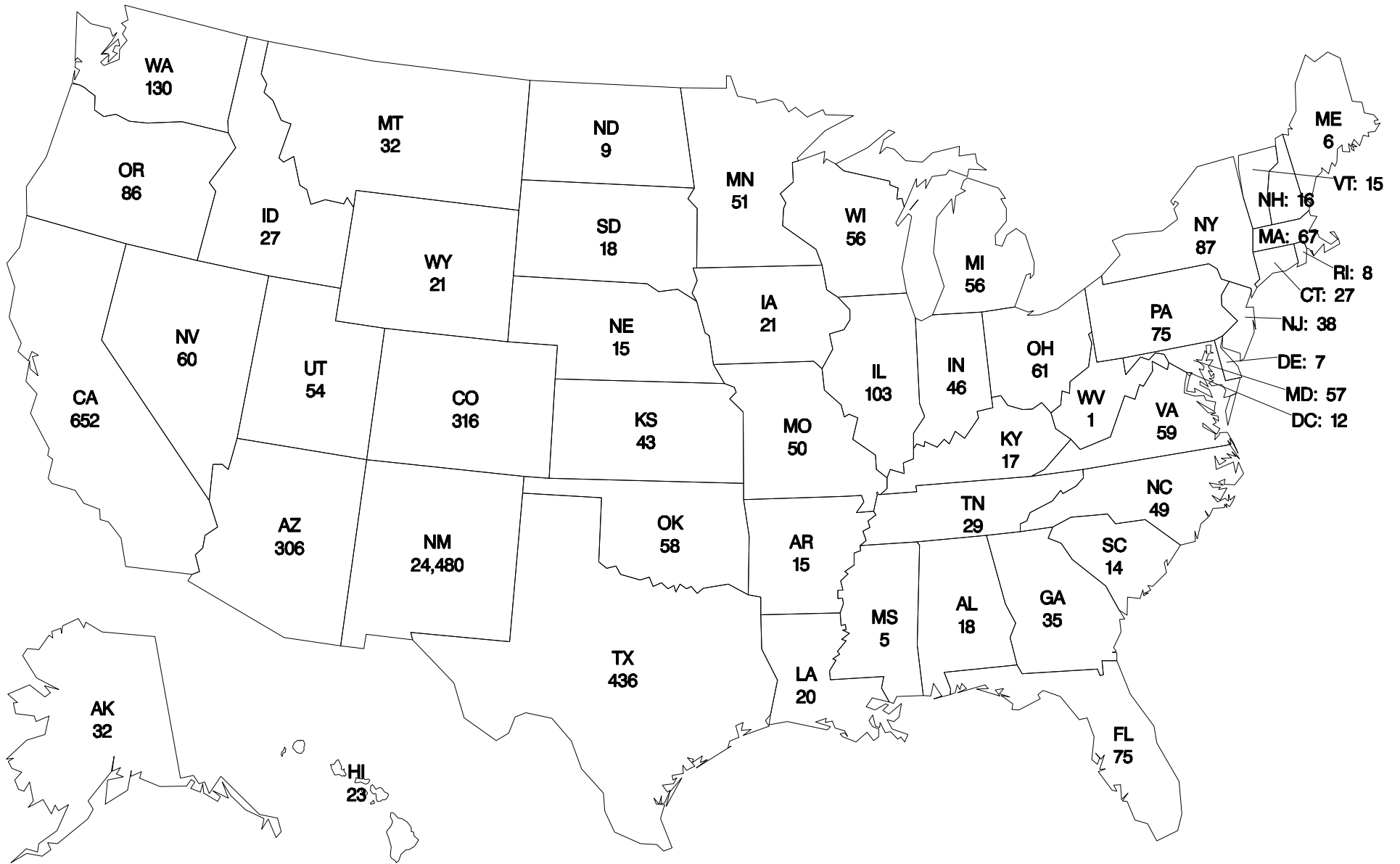
Albuquerque Campus—Based on *Original Residence

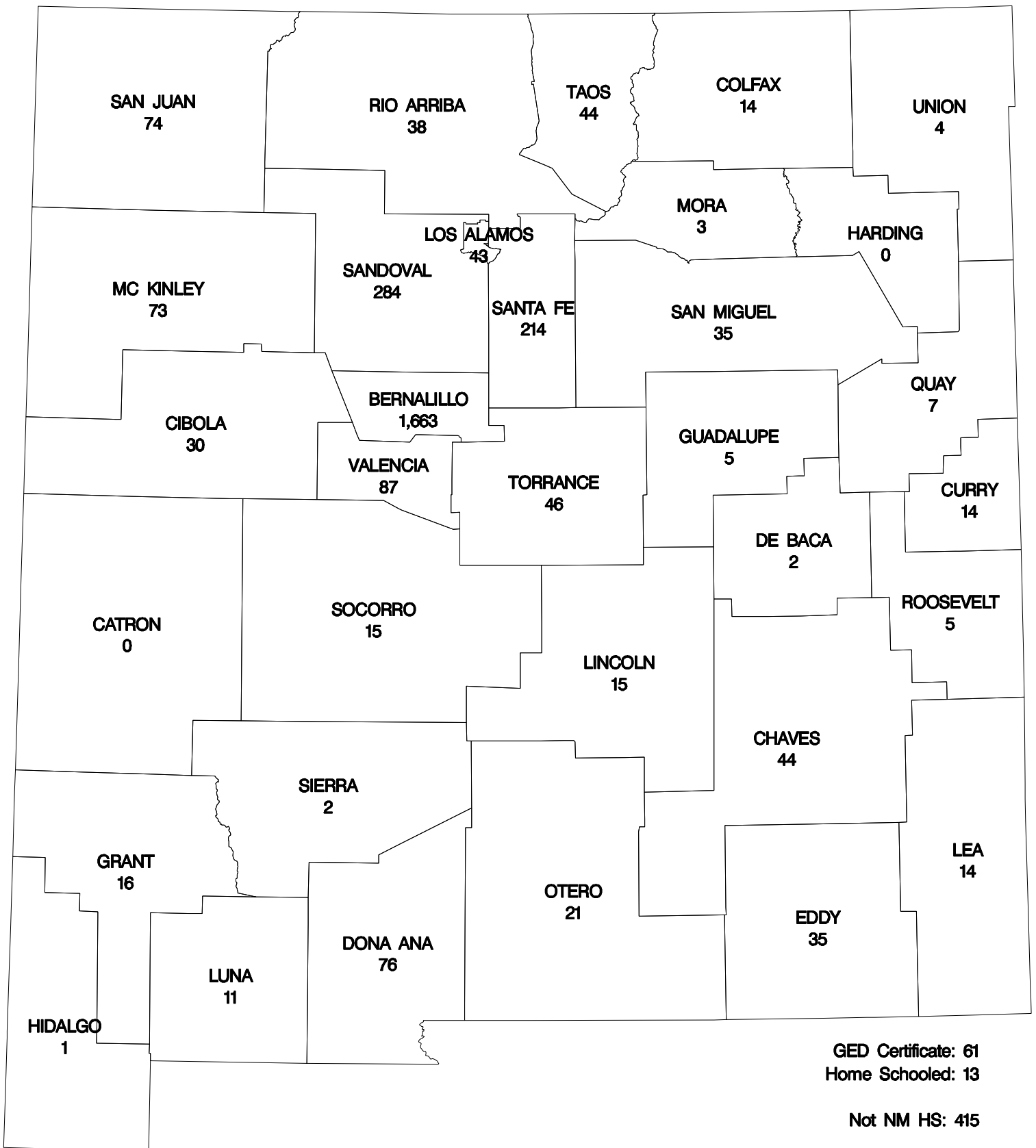
