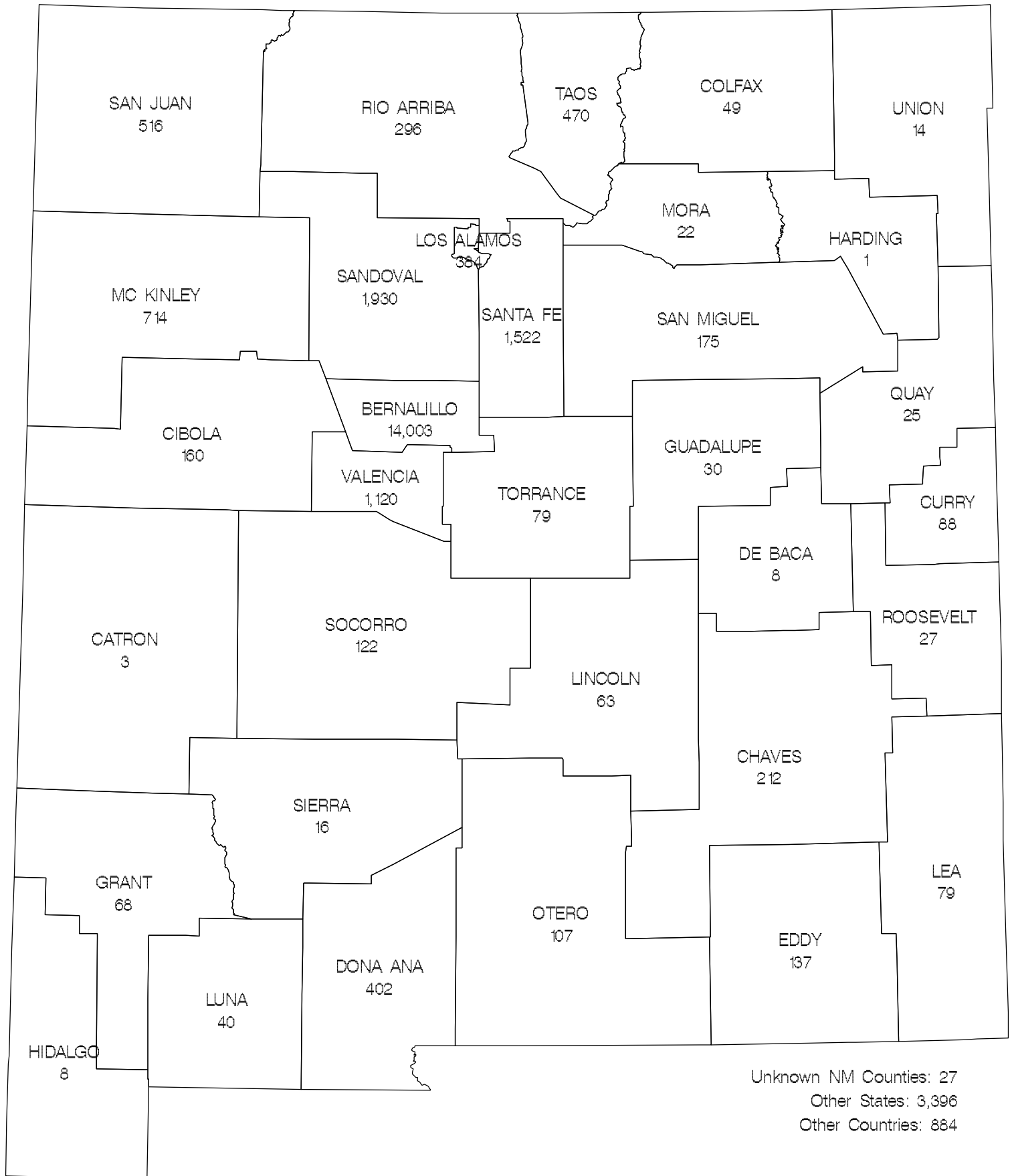

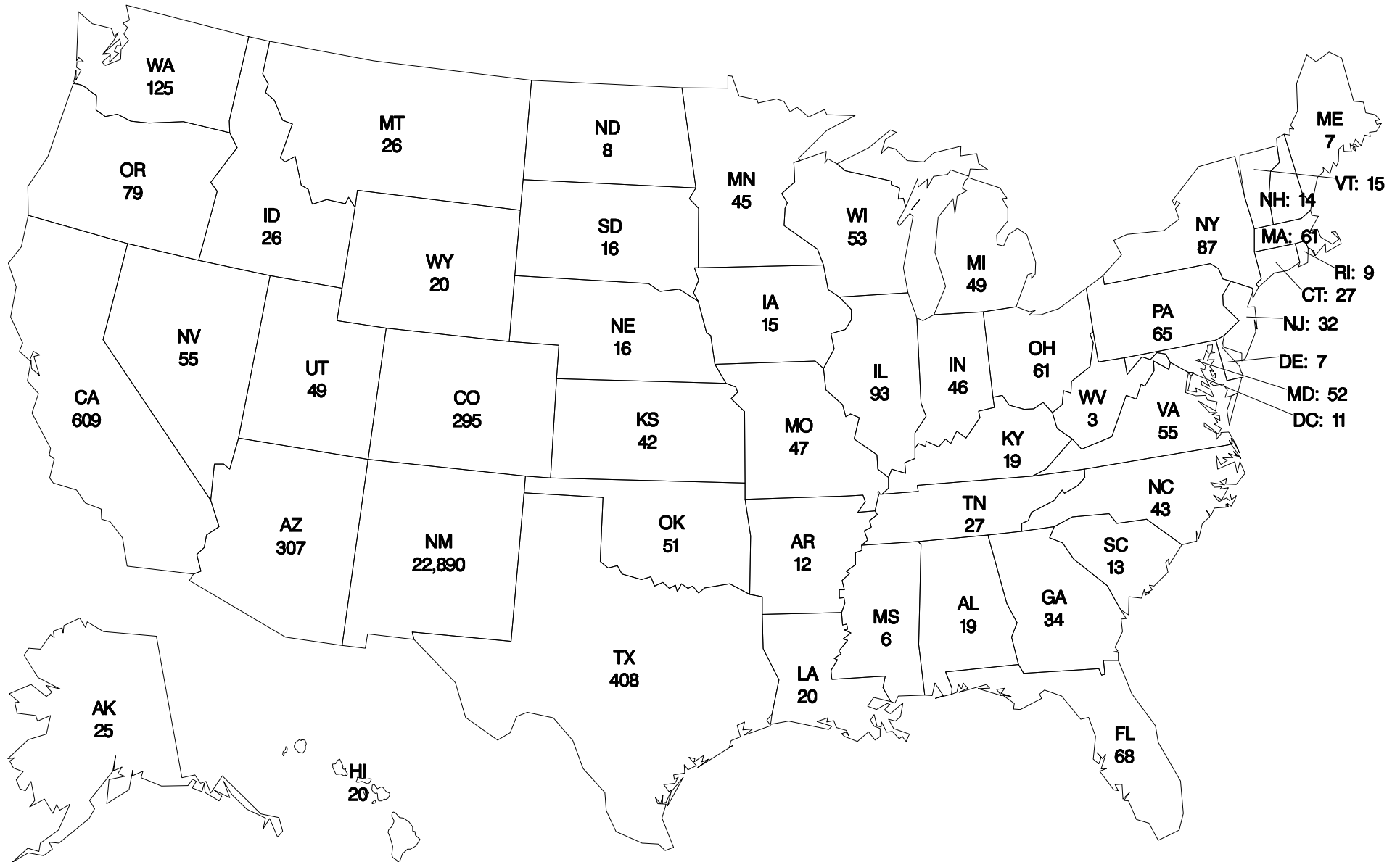
Albuquerque Campus—Based on *Original Residence
